Purpose	<p>The Cabin Crew Preparation course has been designed to develop necessary skills, comprehensive knowledge and build confidence to best prepare you for the aviation industry as a Cabin Crew member.</p> <p>Students will receive recruitment skills, general aviation theory and practical hands-on training to assist them with an airline ground school when they join an airline. Practical training will be done in purpose-built Cabin Crew training facilities.</p>

Study Modes	<p>This course includes an on-campus program combining face-to-face instructor-led theory and practical classes, online textbooks, self-study learning and three online AVI Units of Competency delivered by Aviation Australia. Two units of Competency (HLTAID003 Provide First Aid and SITHAB201 Responsible Service of Alcohol) are delivered by an external provider. This qualification is conducted via a minimum of 24 hours face to face lessons per week with an additional unsupervised minimum self-study commitment of 5 hours per week.</p> <p>Full time training hours are between 0800-1500, however these times are subject to change dependent on class sizes. Between 0800-0900 every day is used for the online AVI units.</p>		
Course Outcomes	<p>On successful completion of this course, participants will receive an Aviation Australia Certificate of Attendance plus an AQF statement of attainment for the 3 AVI units if they decide to complete the online AVI's.</p> <p>An AQF Statement of Attainment for RSA and First Aid from an external provider.</p>
