Entry Requirements	<ul> <li>Entry requirements:</li> <li>Domestic students - Australian or New Zealand Citizen or Permanent Resident: We recommend successful completion of Year 10 (you need to be 18yrs to be Cabin Crew in Australia).</li> <li>Other passport holders: Visa requirements, please visit the Department of Immigration website at www.immi.gov.au to investigate possible visa options. We recommend students have an equivalent of IELTS 5.5 before undertaking this course.</li> </ul>				
Study Modes	This course includes an on-campus program combining face-to-face instructor-led theory and practical classes, online textbooks and self-study learning delivered by Aviation Australia. Two units of Competency (HLTAID011 Provide First Aid and SITHAB201 Responsible Service of Alcohol) are delivered by an external provider. This qualification is conducted via a minimum of 24 hours face to face lessons per week. Full time training hours are between 0800-1500, however these times are subject to change dependent on class sizes.
