

## ACADEMIC EQUIVALENCIES

To meet the academic entry requirement for the Diploma of Aircraft Maintenance Engineering courses at Aviation Australia, applicants must provide evidence of completion of Year 12 or equivalent, with a pass in Mathematics (at minimum Year 10 or equivalent). The table below outlines the international education achievement levels that are equivalent to a Year 12 qualification in Queensland, Australia. Where an applicant is unable to provide this evidence, the below may also be considered:

- Higher level education (i.e. University), or
- Relevant work experience, supported by a resume & employer reference/s, or
- Other forms of suitable academic training, as approved by the Training Manager (or delegate) on a case-by-case basis.

Country	Year 12 Equivalent
Bangladesh	Higher Secondary Certificate/Vocational higher secondary certificate (Minimum CGPA is 3.5 or 60% or grade average of 3 out of 5, GCE A-Level (2 passes)).
China	3 years Senior Middle School (Academic, Technical or Vocational) with reasonable results of more than 60% pass in academic subjects such as Maths, English, Science.
Fiji	Successful completion of Form 7 (prior to 2013) with a C grade in 3 subjects, or grade average of 50 in the best 4 subjects, or Fiji Year 13 Certificate).
Hong Kong	Hong Kong Diploma of Secondary Education (HKDSE)
India	Senior School Certificate - awarded by the Central Board of Secondary Education - 4 Academic: English must be at 70% or above other 3 Subjects each 65% or above.
Indonesia	Certificate of Completion of Senior Secondary Education (Ijazah SMA or Surat Tanda Tamat Belajar: Sekolah Menengah Atas - STTB: SMA) issued by the school.
Malaysia	Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) (4 subject passes - must include Maths).
Maldives	Successful completion of O-levels / High School Certificate with C (Credit Pass) in Maths.
Nepal	School Leaving Certificate + Higher Secondary Certificate - Grade average of 60 and above for grade 11 and 12 results (combined for final results), or School Leaving Certificate + Proficiency Certificate - Grade average of 60 and above for grade 11 and 12 results (combined for final results)
Papua New Guinea	High School Certificate (Minimum 4 C grades).
Pakistan	Pakistani HSSC or Intermediate Certificate with 50% overall minimum (must include Maths), or Certificate or Diploma (Vocational).
Philippines	High School Diploma plus 1 years Post-Secondary School or 2 years any bachelor's degree.
Singapore	Singapore/Cambridge GCE Advanced Level Certificate with grade 'E' or higher in 2 Advanced Level subjects and 3 Ordinary Level subjects, or Completion of a Technician Diploma/Certificate from a Polytechnic.
Solomon Islands	Successful completion of Pacific Senior Secondary Certificate with grade average of 2 in final year results (must include Maths) or Completion of pre-tertiary or foundation course.
South Korea	Ilbankye Kodung Hakkyo (General Senior High School Certificate).
Sri Lanka	Sri Lankan General Certificate of Education (Ordinary Level) - C (Credit Pass) in Maths.
Taiwan	Senior High School Diploma or Senior Vocational School Diploma.
Thailand	Thailand Certificate of Secondary Education (Matayom 6 or MS 6).
Vietnam	Upper Secondary Education Graduation Diploma (Bang Tot Nghiep Trung Hoc Pho Thong) - with a 7.0 GPA.
Zimbabwe	Successful completion of the ZIMSEC A Level Certificate with a minimum of one A-level with a grade of E or above and four O-level subjects passed with a Grade of D or above, or National Diploma, National Technician Certificate, or advanced National Craft Certificate.
