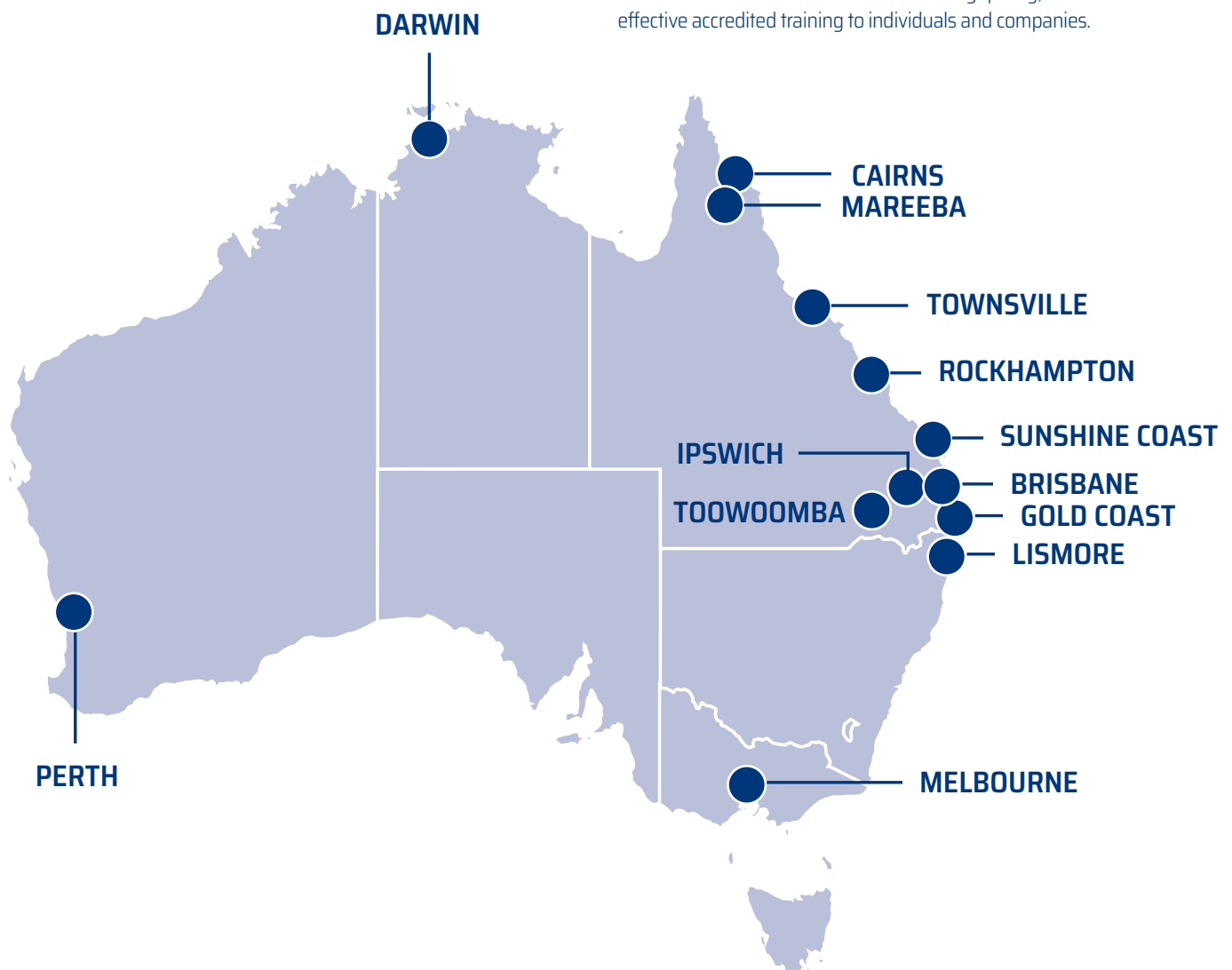

TO BECOME AN AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE ENGINEER

Aviation Australia offers a range of pathways to become an Aircraft Maintenance Engineer, from in-school programs and pre-apprenticeship aircraft maintenance courses to Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) assessments and specialised industry training. Our programs are designed to provide you with the essential skills and knowledge needed to launch your aviation career.

Training is delivered by highly experienced instructors with extensive backgrounds in both Civil and Defence aviation sectors. Students will complete the core theoretical components required for the Certificate IV in Aeroskills (Avionics, Mechanical, or Structures). All training is aligned with the CASR Part 66 basic knowledge syllabus, and examinations are conducted in accordance with CASR Part 66 requirements.

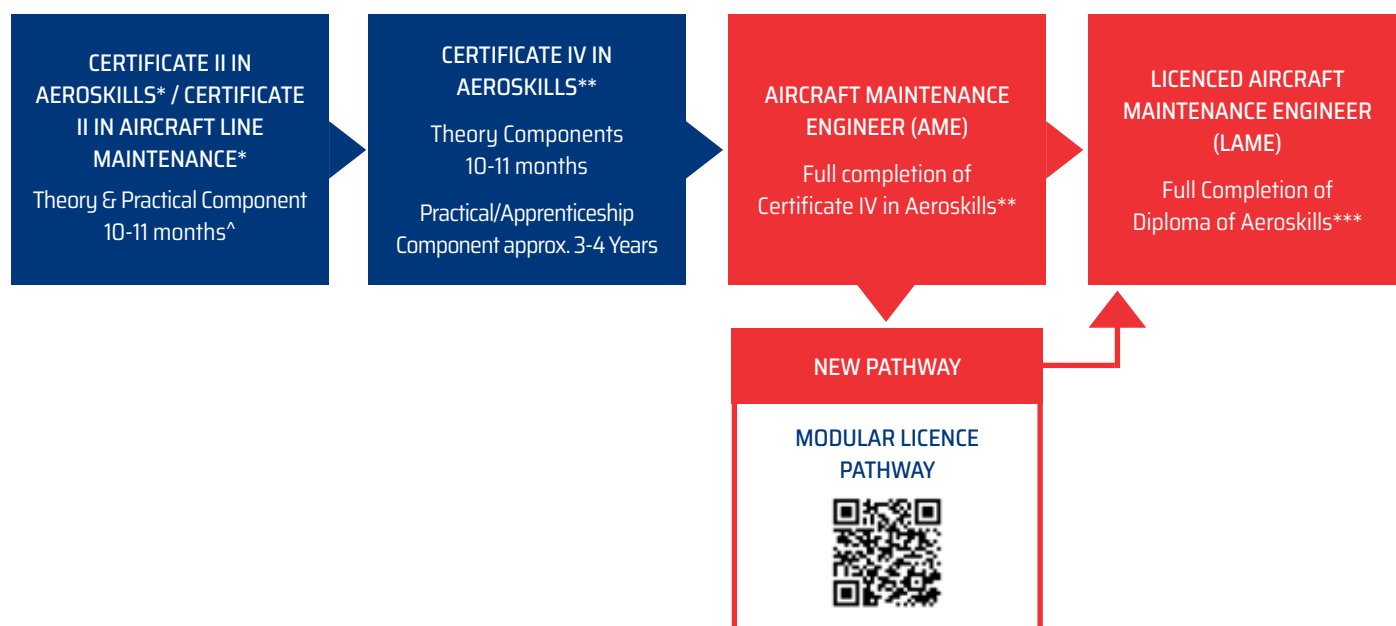

MEA20518 – CERTIFICATE II IN AIRCRAFT LINE MAINTENANCE

AEROSPACE GATEWAY TO INDUSTRY SCHOOLS PROGRAM

Hosted by Aviation Australia, the Aerospace Gateway to Industry Schools Program connects high school students with real-world career pathways in aviation and aerospace. It builds practical skills and industry awareness through hands-on experiences, direct engagement with aviation professionals, and strong school partnerships—preparing students for future careers in Queensland's growing aerospace sector.



MEA20418 – CERTIFICATE II IN AEROSKILLS (WA)

This 12 month course is delivered two days-per-week and provides the foundational knowledge and skills required to perform specified maintenance tasks on a flight line or at a departure gate. This course is aimed at school students seeking to enter or better understand the aviation industry.

Include hands-on exposure to a range of aircraft components including electrical, hydraulic, pneumatic, electro-hydraulic, and electro-pneumatic systems; as well as the maintenance requirements for aircraft and equipment.

WHY STUDY

TO BECOME AN AIRCRAFT MAINTENANCE ENGINEER

PRE-APPRENTICESHIP COURSES

MEA40718 – CERTIFICATE IV IN AEROSKILLS (MECHANICAL)

The Mechanical trade stream focuses on the aircraft's engines, systems, and moving components that keep the aircraft operating safely and efficiently. Students build a strong foundation in mathematics, physics, electrical principles, aerodynamics, aircraft materials, and maintenance practices before progressing into specialised mechanical subjects. Training covers gas turbine engines, propeller systems, fuel systems, flight controls, brakes and undercarriage systems, cabin pressurisation, and other aircraft mechanical systems. Graduates typically work on the inspection, maintenance, troubleshooting, repair, and replacement of aircraft engines and associated systems, ensuring aircraft remain airworthy and operational.

- ☑ Pursue an apprenticeship with your theory Certificate of Results so you can be on the tools and specialise in mechanical systems by building on advanced diagnostic, maintenance, and component-servicing skills and honing your hands-on expertise to become a recognised industry professional

MEA41322 – CERTIFICATE IV IN AEROSKILLS (STRUCTURES)

The Structures trade stream includes all of the same core theory and mechanical training delivered in the Mechanical trade stream, providing students with the same foundational knowledge of aircraft systems, aerodynamics, engines, materials, and maintenance practices. In addition, students complete specialist structural electives that focus on the manufacture, inspection, maintenance, modification, and repair of aircraft structures. Training includes sheet metal fabrication, composite repairs, structural assembly, and bonding techniques using advanced materials such as carbon fibre, Kevlar, and aluminium alloys. This broader skill set allows graduates to work on both aircraft mechanical systems and structural components, making Structures an ideal pathway for those interested in the complete maintenance and repair of aircraft.

MEA40618 – CERTIFICATE IV IN AEROSKILLS (AVIONICS)

Develop core skills in electronics fundamentals to understand circuits, components, and signal behaviour. The stream also introduces digital techniques and electronic instrument systems, covering materials and hardware in aircraft systems and technologies. These units equip learners with the capability to maintain, troubleshoot, and support avionic systems essential to safe and efficient aircraft propulsion and operation.

Applying your theory to electrical, instrument and communication systems to inspect, test and troubleshoot complex aircraft components on a variety of aircraft from Helicopters to A380's

By completing your theoretical requirements before entering the workplace, you'll start your apprenticeship already prepared for practical training. This preparatory course provides the core knowledge and specialisation needed for Aircraft Maintenance Engineering so that you can secure an apprenticeship with confidence. This early readiness helps you progress quickly and make meaningful impact as soon as your apprenticeship begins.

Note: CASA recognises a score of 75% in the applicable examinations as the benchmark required for progression toward becoming a Licenced Aircraft Maintenance Engineer (LAME).

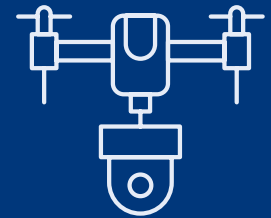

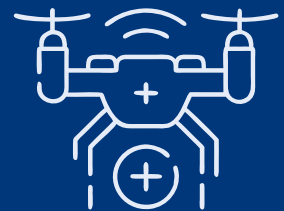

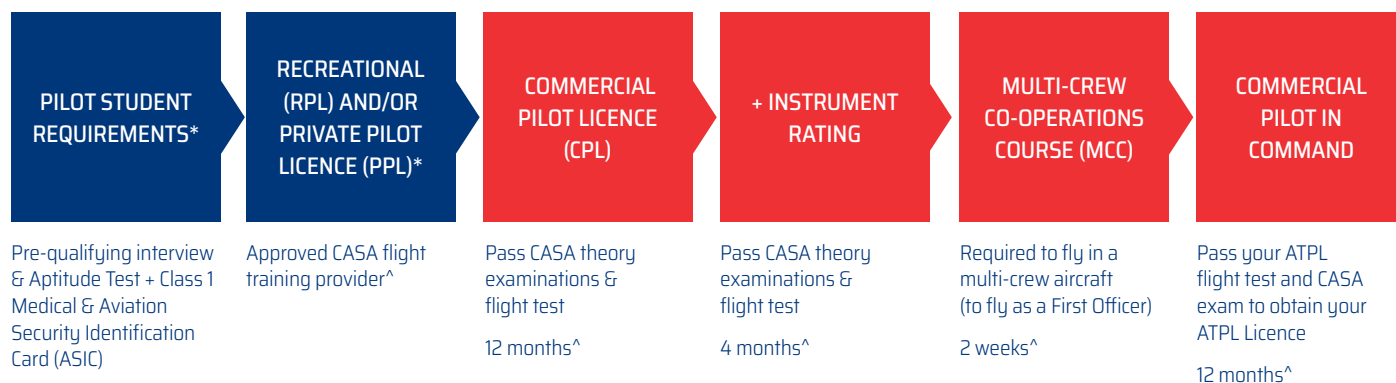

AVI50519 – DIPLOMA OF AVIATION (INSTRUMENT RATING)

Instrument rating training focuses on knowledge and skills for Instrument Rating certification by the Civil Aviation Safety Authority (CASA) under Part 61 Flight Crew licencing.

UNITS

The Diploma of Aviation (Instrument Rating) is a specialised course designed to provide all the technical and non-technical skills needed to operate aeroplanes under the instrument flight rules. Additionally, the course covers the skills, knowledge and experience required to attain a Multi Engine Aeroplane Class Rating (MEACR).
